

Accomplishments

- Revised and approved updated bylaws with a new mission statement and purpose to coordinate activities of other history and cultural arts organizations and to advocate for historic preservation throughout Washington County.
- DSU Archivist Kathleen Broeder oversaw the 36th Annual Juanita Brooks Lecture held Thursday, March 28, 2019, in the Cox Auditorium on the DSU Campus. Richard Saunders presented, "Dear Juanita, Dear Dale" about the relationship between Juanita Brooks and Dale Morgan.
- Completed management of the Veterans Oral History Project as the Fiscal Agent for a grant from Utah Humanities under a verbal contract with Project Manager Randy Bunn.
- Finalized an agreement with St. George City to open the Pioneer Courthouse for tours and meetings in partnership with the DUP, SUP, and Arts to Zion.
- Added \$13,000 to the \$6,600 raised previously for the Juanita Brooks Statue. Paid out \$10,000 to sculptor Annette Everett for the maquette, leaving a balance of \$9,500 in the fundraising account at the end of 2019.

Grants

- Made \$500 final payment to Santa Clara Historical Society at the completion of the LeVan Martineau Oral History project.
- Awarded \$981.65 total to Grafton Heritage Partners to replace interpretive signs in Grafton.
