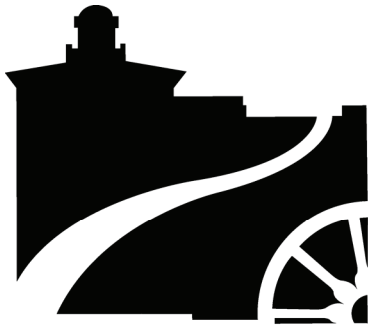

The Washington County Historical Society (WCHS) is a nonprofit organization formed to promote, protect and perpetuate the history of Washington County, Utah. It embraces the county's community historical societies and supports their efforts to preserve our history.

The WCHS Board is comprised of members representing many local historical societies and other historically-minded citizens, all working together to preserve, protect and restore the history of Washington County, Utah. The Board meets from 10 AM until Noon on the last Wednesday of each month, September through May.

Recent Grants Awarded to Local Communities by the WCHS:

- ▶ 2006 - \$1000 given to the Ivins Historical Society for the restoration of the Historic Adobe Post Office.
- ▶ 2006 - \$1000 also given to the Harmony Heritage Service Organization for a fence to protect the New Harmony Fort built by John D. Lee in 1854.
- ▶ 2007 - \$1000 given to the Santa Clara Historical Society for restoring the Relief Society House on its 100th anniversary.
- ▶ 2007 - \$1000 also given to the Town of Leeds for a metal interpretive signage plaque for the Town Hall.
- ▶ 2008 - \$1000 was given to the Hurricane Valley Museum to remodel the restrooms and to repair and replace glass in the Pioneer Museum.
- ▶ 2008 - \$1000 also given to the Town of Virgin for their Virgin Town Old Church restoration project.
- ▶ 2009 - \$1000 given to Fort Harmony Historical Society to help preserve the San Daniel Camp, part of the 1776 Expedition on the Old Spanish Trail.
- ▶ 2009 - \$1000 also given to the Washington City Historical Society in honor of the 100th anniversary of the Old School Building, to showcase artifacts of early educators and principals in Washington City.
- ▶ 2010 - \$1000 given to Leeds Historic Preservation to restore the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) Camp in Leeds.
